Called Meeting Minutes February 7, 2023

Chairman Dill called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Franklin made a MOTION to adopt the Agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guynn and was APPROVED.

ED Griffin disclosed she has a conflict of interest being she is a board member of the Pine Bluff Civic Auditorium Complex Commission and the executive director of the Pine Bluff Urban Renewal Agency.

Mayor Washington read a proposed Resolution for the PBURA to contribute \$2,935,140 to support the financing and construction of the Mriott Convention Center Hotel. Mayor Washington has polled all city council members and all but one support this request. This is the final piece of the funding to complete the financing package.

Grandon Gray, P3 Group, stated he had contacted banks in Arkansas for funding a USDA loan. No banks in the state make these types of loans. He has contacted Farmers State Bank of Alto Pass to make the loan. The Public Facilities Board has approved this lender.

Ryan Watley, GFPB, reported on the impact of this project on the financials of two other projects the PBURA has committed to: Sixth and Main Street Project and the Go Kart Track. There is sufficient cash flow to keep all three projects on schedule.

Commissioner Franklin made a motion to adopt the Resolution to provide an equity contribution of \$2,935,140 to support the financing and construction of the Marioot Convention Center Hotel. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mouser with all approving except for Dill who abstained.

Public Comments were made.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
